Time	Instructions	
24 Hours Before	Prepare Golytely	
	• Fill container to "fill" line with water and mix until dissolved	
	Chill if desired	
	• NO solid foods, only clear liquids including:	
	• Water	
	Apple, White Grape, & White Cranberry juices without pulp	
	Clear soup Broth	
	Tea or Coffee (No milk, cream)	
	Gatorade / Powerade (NO red, orange, or purple colors)	
	• Jell-O (NO red, orange, or purple colors)	
	Popsicles or Sorbet (NO red, orange, or purple colors)	
	No Alcohol	
Dose 1	• Drink the first half of the Golytely solution steadily over the next hour and a half	
	• Drink 1 cup (8oz) every 10 minutes or so for a total of 8 cups (64oz)	
Taken at 5pm night before	Half of the solution should remain in the container	
procedure	Re-chill the remaining half if desired	
After Dose 1	Continue drinking clear liquids	
	Drink at least 2 more cups (16oz) of clear liquids throughout the day	
Dose 2	Drink the second half of the Golytely solution steadily over the next hour and a	
Taken 6 hours prior to	half	
procedure time	• Drink 1 cup (8oz) every 10 minutes or so for a total of 8 cups (64oz)	
	The container should now be empty	
After Dose 2	Continue drinking clear liquids up to 3 hours before procedure	
3 Hours Before	 Nothing to eat or drink (other than essential medications) 3 hours before procedure 	

<u>Important</u>	
f you experience nausea, bloating or vomiting, try drinking the solution more slowly or cooling the liquid on ice.	
Note: Individual responses to laxatives do vary; this prep may cause multiple bowel movements. This prep often	
vorks within 30 minutes, but it may take as long as 4-6 hours.	
omeone must accompany you and take you home after the procedure. Do not drive for 8 hours after your	
rocedure.
